4.1. Construction Update

Site Visit Reports #33 and #34 were discussed. R. Crothers reported the following regarding the construction progress:

✓ Insurance adjusters and environmental consultants have assessed the site for a second time. More drywall is to be removed. The area of carpet on the second floor

that sustained water damage has been assessed by the manufacturer and will need to be replaced to maintain the warranty. A report from the elevator consultant is due today and a report on possible mechanical issues with the boiler will take place when gas is turned on at the site.

- ✓ Interior painting is progressing.
- ✓ Excavation work along the Johnson Street façade is now active. A concrete base is being poured and additional soil removal is taking place.
- ✓ A small repair is taking place on the exterior Parish House wall along Bagot Street.
- ✓ Preparations are underway for the sidewalk repair on Bagot Street.
- ✓ Painting of the new exterior brick on the Johnson Street façade is almost complete.
- ✓ Undercoat for the liquid applied flooring on the second floor is being applied today. The finish coat will be applied next week.
- ✓ Windows are complete in all areas except the front elevation.
- ✓ Work continues on additional sprinklers and the architectural glass walls.

The quality of work being completed continues to be good.

4.4. Commissioning Report

A binder containing pre-commissioning test files is located on site. Contractors will complete and sign required paperwork as systems are tested.
